- As of Dec 31st, we have raised \$42,000. We have earmarked money for \$54,000 so we are \$12,000 short.
 - Yearbook, Original Works, and Navy Basketball game will bring in more money
 - Also the Spring Fundraiser will bring in money
 - Runner's Club has \$1,000 budget but they are not holding it in the mornings any longer, they are doing in during P.E. class. They are still planning to give toe tokens and t-shirts so budget remains for now.

1st VP Report -- Sue Martin

- Spring Fundraiser
 - Alexis Lloyd will run the silent auction just like last year; will start March 1st and end on March 15th. We are pairing it with the Dogfish Head Dining for Navy (15% of all sales go to PTO, including alcohol on March 15th).
 - Suggestion to put auction sheets out at Dogfish for additional bidding; not baskets, just sheets describing the items up for bid.
 - We need volunteers and are excited about this event.
- Leslie Stuart starting work on an auction for next school year (completely different event).

2nd VP Report -- Catherine Martin

- Had a good response to September Committee Chair meeting. Will be holding another meeting in February to touch base for Spring activities. Date will be set shortly.
- Need date for End of Year picnic.
